



Water Around the World NVON Project in Common 2013 – 2015

Final Report

The NVON Project in Common for 2013-2015 is “Water Around The World.” The objective of the three-year international project is to present an overview of how water is an essential resource and fundamental building block of life, present an awareness of problems that could arise when clean water is lacking in communities, and how we can help those in need around the world.

Member states were encouraged to participate by raising funds to purchase filters through a myriad of suggested ways, i.e. bake sales, yard sales, fund drives, bottle and can collection, etc.

In 2013, \$10,867.90 was collected. \$40,375.07 was collected in 2014 and \$34,973.59 in 2015.

As of March 1, 2016 \$96,500.00 had been contributed to purchase water filters. NVON has impacted lives worldwide one filter at a time in such places as Haiti, Zimbabwe, Northern Mozambique, Thailand, Sierra Leone and most recently Nepal following the earthquake.

At the 2015 Conference, we voted to continue this project as an international focus so that we may continue to impact lives . . . one filter at a time!
